Purpose

Contest Rules

1. Contestants must attend the upcoming Imperial Session.
2. Complete the contest application form.
3. Must wear dress-up attire. Note: Notify the team in advance if a costume will be worn for the talent part of the competition. Two-minutes max for changing.
4. Submit ONE photo (head and shoulders). Photos must be submitted in color, 300-dpi or higher. Photo size between 1 MB -3 MB.
5. Upon arrival to Headquarters submit a jump drive with the youth's performance music at the Activities Check-in Station. Remember to pick it up at the end of the conference.
6. Contestants must present a talent (dance, song, speech, play an instrument) at the Talent Show. Maximum performance time: 2 minutes.
7. Email the photo and application form to: youthdirector@aeaonms.org
In the subject line, write King & Queen Contestant submittal. **Deadline: April 1, 2026**

If your youth have these attributes and plans to attend the upcoming Imperial Session, they are eligible to compete. Contest rules and details are listed below.



Contest Rules

1. Contestants must attend the upcoming Imperial Session.
2. Complete the contest application form.
3. Submit a typewritten essay. Topic: **“Celebrating Our Heritage...Past, Present and Future.**
4. Based on your intended career choice tie it to various colors. Be creative and tell us how the colors tie into or describe your future. For instance, ***I want to be a Sheriff which represents the green. I want to be a Sheriff because.... In order become a sheriff, I need education in..., etc.***
5. Minimum words: Juniors – 100 and Seniors – 200
6. Contestants must wear dress-up attire (Church attire, business casual, evening wear, etc.)
7. Submit ONE photo (head and shoulders). Photos must be submitted in color, 300-dpi or higher. Photo size between 1 MB -3 MB. Parent(s) must submit a signed Photo Release Form.
8. Upon arrival to Headquarters, submit a jump drive with the youth's performance music at the Activities Check-in Station. Remember to pick it up at the end of the conference.
9. Contestants must present a talent (dance, song, speech, play an instrument) as well as read their essay at the Talent Show. Minimum performance time: Juniors – 3 minutes and Seniors – 4 minutes.
10. Email the photo and all forms to: youthdirector@aeonms.org In the subject line, write King & Queen Contestant submittal. **Deadline: April 1, 2026.**
