- 6. Contestants must present a talent (dance, song, speech, play an instrument) at the Awards Ceremony. Maximum performance time: 3 minutes.

- 6. Submit ONE photo (head and shoulders). Photos must be submitted in color, 300-dpi or higher. Phot size between 1 MB -3 MB.
- 7. Parent(s) must submit a signed Photo Release Form.
- 8. Contestants must present a talent (dance, song, speech, play an instrument) at the Awards Ceremony. Minimum performance time: Juniors 5 minutes and Seniors 7 minutes.
